SENATE BILL NO. 3092
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF THE WORKING
2 CASH-STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE
3 STATE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other sums heretofore
6 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Working
8 Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the
9 Veterans Affairs Board for the purpose of replacing lost income
10 due to the temporary closing of the Collins State Veterans Home
11 and funding uninsured expenses related to the extensive damage
12 caused by Hurricane Katrina, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
13 2006..... \$ 700,000.00.

14 **SECTION 2.** As a condition of receiving the money
15 appropriated by Section 1 of this act, the Veterans Affairs Board
16 shall pay into the State General Fund any funds that the board
17 receives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) or
18 any other federal agency as reimbursement for any of the purposes
19 described in Section 1 of this act.

20 **SECTION 3.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
21 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
22 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
23 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
24 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
25 in the manner provided by law.

26 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
27 and after its passage.
