- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Mark Pickering of Warren County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 convictions of the crimes of burglary and grand larceny in Warren
- 8 County, Mississippi, in 1981, and who was sentenced to serve two
- 9 (2) years in the custody of the Department of Corrections. His
- 10 sentence was suspended and he was placed on probation for two (2)
- 11 years. His probation was terminated on December 2, 1982. Since
- 12 that time, he has conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable
- 13 citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after its passage.
