2	BOYCOTT TRAVEL TO ARUBA.
3	WHEREAS, the citizens of this state, as well as the nation,
4	are deeply saddened over the disappearance of Birmingham resident
5	and former Mississippi resident Natalee Holloway during her senior
6	high school trip to Aruba; and
7	WHEREAS, tourism accounts for 70% of the gross domestic
8	product of Aruba. The Dutch island receives some 728,000 visitors

- 9 each year and an additional 550,000 cruise ship passengers. More
- than 70% of these tourists are from the United States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, currently the Aruban officials have failed to crack
- down on the parties involved in this case; and 12
- WHEREAS, we will not tolerate a lack of justice for an 13
- American citizen: 14
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 15
- 16 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- we do hereby urge all Mississippians to boycott travel to Aruba. 17
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be forwarded by 18
- the Secretary of State to the President of the United States and 19
- 20 members of the Mississippi congressional delegation and be made
- available to members of the Capitol Press Corps. 21
