## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 508

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 70
--

- 2 MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO PROVIDE THAT ALL STATE
- 3 GENERAL OBLIGATION OR REVENUE BOND BILLS SHALL ONLY AUTHORIZE
- 4 FUNDING FOR ONE SINGLE PROJECT OR PURPOSE.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 6 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 7 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 8 state:
- 9 Amend Section 70, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 Section 70. No revenue bill, or any bill providing for
- 12 assessments of property for taxation, shall become a law except by
- 13 a vote of at least three-fifths (3/5) of the members of each house
- 14 present and voting. Further, all state general obligation or
- 15 revenue bond bills shall only authorize funding for the
- 16 acquisition, construction, equipping or other development of one
- single project or purpose.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the amendment in this resolution
- 19 shall be submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be
- 20 held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2007
- 21 as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by general law.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of the amendment
- 23 for the ballot shall read as follows: "This amendment limits each
- 24 general obligation or revenue bill introduced or passed in the
- 25 State Legislature to one single project or purpose."
