SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 540

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO AMEND THE MISSISSIPPI 1 2 CONSTITUTION OF 1890 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION ESTABLISHING THE 3 RIGHT TO HUNT AND FISH AS A CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi 6 7 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the 8 state: 9 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by adding a new 10 section to read as follows: Section ___. Hunting, trapping and fishing and the taking of 11 wild game species are a valued part of our heritage and will be 12 forever preserved for the people. Fish and wildlife shall be 13 managed by laws and regulations that provide persons with the 14 continued opportunity to take, by traditional means and methods, 15 16 species traditionally pursued by hunters, anglers and trappers. Fish and wildlife management, including taking, shall be 17 consistent with the state's duty to protect this heritage and its 18 19 duty to conserve wild animals, birds and fish. Hunting, fishing or trapping by sportsmen shall always be a preferred and available 20 21 means of controlling all invasive or overpopulated species. Any person who is licensed or exempt from licensure by state law or 22 23 regulation to hunt, fish or trap and who is adversely affected by a failure to comply with this section shall have a private cause 24 of action to enforce this section. The right of the people to 25 26 hunt, fish, trap and harvest game shall be subject only to such regulations and restrictions as the Legislature may prescribe by 2.7 general law. - This amendment shall be known as the "Sportsperson's Bill of
- 34 Rights."
- 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be
- 36 submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on
- 37 the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2006, as
- 38 provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law.
- 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 40 constitutional amendment for the ballot shall read as follows:
- 41 "This amendment makes hunting and fishing constitutional rights in
- 42 Mississippi, subject to applicable laws and regulations."
