## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 563

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE LIFE OF JAMES M. 1 RICHARDSON, WORLD WAR II VETERAN AND FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE MISSISSIPPI BAPTIST CONVENTION, AND EXPRESSING THE SYMPATHY OF THE 2 3 4 LEGISLATURE. 5 WHEREAS, James M. Richardson, 82, died on December 30, 2005, 6 in Madison, Mississippi; and 7 WHEREAS, Richardson was a veteran, serving with the 96th Evacuation Hospital in Europe during World War II; and 8 9 WHEREAS, he graduated from Mississippi College, and was 10 married to Narcissa Alexander Richardson for 57 years; and WHEREAS, Richardson was a Pastor in Mississippi for over 40 11 years, pastoring Calvary Baptist Church, West Point, Mississippi; 12 First Baptist Church, Leland, Mississippi; and First Baptist 13 Church, Madison, Mississippi; and 14 WHEREAS, he was a trustee of several local, state and 15 16 national boards, including the Home Mission Board, the Foreign 17 Mission Board, the Mississippi Baptist Convention Board, the Baptist Memorial Hospital Board (Memphis, Tennessee) and the 18 19 Mississippi College Board of Trustees; and WHEREAS, he served two terms as President of the Mississippi 20 21 Baptist Convention; and WHEREAS, survivors include his wife; three sons and spouses: 22 23 Jay and Martha Richardson of Madison; Gary and Janet Richardson of 24 Oxford; and Ian and Annette Richardson of Madison; one daughter (and spouse); Vivien and Keith Baty of Slidell, Louisiana; eight 25 26 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren; and WHEREAS, throughout his life and ministry, he was able to 27 28 touch many lives through his kindness, generosity and his love of \*SS02/R1214\* S.
