A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING VIC 2 PURVIS, STAR COLLEGE QUARTERBACK AND COLOR COMMENTATOR FOR SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI FROM PUCKETT AND MORTON, MISSISSIPPI, UPON 3 4 HIS INDUCTION INTO THE MISSISSIPPI SPORTS HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 5 2006. WHEREAS, the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame has unveiled its б 7 Class of 2006, which features Vic Purvis, star college quarterback and radio color commentator for the University of Southern 8 9 Mississippi "Golden Eagles" Football Team from Puckett and Morton, 10 Mississippi; and WHEREAS, Vic Purvis earned 14 letters in football, 11 basketball, baseball and track at Puckett and Morton High Schools 12 13 and led his football teams in high school to a record of 22-6-3. 14 He was MVP of the Capital Athletic Conference and played in the 1961 Mississippi High School All-Star Football game; and 15 16 WHEREAS, a three-year letterman as quarterback at the University of Southern Mississippi from 1963 to 1965, he was 17 coached by Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame member Thad "Pie" Vann 18 19 and led USM to a record of 18-8-1 during his college career. Не established numerous rushing records at the school, had two 20 21 consecutive 200+ yard rushing performances against Memphis and 22 Richmond in 1965 which made national headlines, paced USM in passing and total offense for three straight seasons and finished 23 his college career with 1,738 yards passing, 1,497 yards rushing 24 and 10 touchdowns; and 25

WHEREAS, Vic was Honorable Mention All-American and Academic 26 27 All-American who was selected for USM student Hall of Fame and 28 chosen Mr. USM; and

WHEREAS, he played for the Boston Patriots of the AFL for two seasons in 1966 and 1967 after signing with the club as a free agent defensive back and kick returner. His teammates included NFL Hall of Fame LB Nick Buoniconti and Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame member DL Eddie Khayat; and

34 WHEREAS, owner of Purvis Sales and Marketing, his 35 broadcasting career began in 1974 as color commentator at USM for 36 "Golden Eagle" football and he has broadcast over 345 USM games; 37 and

38 WHEREAS, counting games as a player and broadcaster, Vic 39 Purvis has been involved in 372 USM gridiron contests; and WHEREAS, he was honored with induction into the USM Athletic 40 Hall of Fame in his first year of eligibility in 1972; and 41 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this 42 outstanding athlete and sports announcer who has brought honor to 43 his community, his university and to the State of Mississippi: 44 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 45 46 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Vic Purvis, star college 47 48 quarterback and radio color commentator for the University of Southern Mississippi "Golden Eagles" Football Team from Puckett 49 50 and Morton, Mississippi, upon his induction into the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2006, and wish him and his family 51 continued success in all their future endeavors. 52
