SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 626

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE POSITIVE COACHING 1 2 CAREER OF OLE MISS BASKETBALL COACH ROD BARNES. 3 WHEREAS, University of Mississippi Athletics Director Pete 4 Boone has announced that Ole Miss Boys Basketball Head Coach Rod Barnes will step down at the end of the 2005-2006 season; and 5 WHEREAS, Barnes has served in his present position for the 6 7 last eight years; and 8 WHEREAS, Rod Barnes has been a very positive and important 9 part of Ole Miss basketball history throughout his playing and coaching career. He has always represented the University with 10 11 the utmost class and integrity; and WHEREAS, during his eight years at the helm of the Rebel 12 Basketball Program, Barnes has risen to second on the Ole Miss 13 career list for coaching victories, four behind B.L. "Country" 14 Graham's school record of 145. The 2001 Naismith and 15 CollegeInsider.com National Coach of the Year, Barnes has a 16 141-107 record as Rebel Head Coach and a 50-77 mark in SEC play. 17 His .569 overall winning percentage is the highest by an Ole Miss 18 Coach since 1938, and the best of any Rebel mentor of seven-plus 19 20 years; and WHEREAS, in 2000-2001, Barnes guided Ole Miss to a 21 22 school-record 27 wins, the program's first NCAA Tournament Sweet 23 16 berth and a No. 9 final national ranking. Another winning season and postseason tournament followed in 2001-2002, both were 24 25 the fourth under Barnes; and WHEREAS, a 1988 graduate of Ole Miss, Rod Barnes served as an 26 Assistant Coach under Rob Evans from 1993-1998 before being named 27 *SS02/R1369* S. Head Coach of the Rebels on April 9, 1998. Barnes played at Ole Miss from 1985-1988 and was an honorable mention All-American selection his Senior season. He is the only person in SEC history to earn both All-SEC and SEC Coach of the Year honors; and WHEREAS, as a player, Assistant Coach and Head Coach, Barnes has spent 17 seasons with Ole Miss basketball; and
