A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO CREATE A STUDY COMMITTEE FOR THE 1 PURPOSE OF STUDYING THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A CIVIL RIGHTS 2 3 MUSEUM IN THE CITY OF JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI. 4 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that there is a need to closely examine and further study the feasibility of establishing 5 a civil rights museum in the City of Jackson, Mississippi: 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 7 8 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That: 9 There is hereby created a study committee for the purpose of 10 studying the feasibility of establishing a civil rights museum in 11 the City of Jackson, Mississippi. The study committee shall be 12 13 composed of the following: The Executive Director of the State Department of 14 (a) 15 Archives and History, or his designee; 16 (b) Three (3) members of the Senate to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor; 17 Three (3) members of the House of Representatives 18 (C) to be appointed by the Speaker of the House; and 19 20 Members of the committee who are not legislators shall not 21 receive any compensation or per diem, but may receive travel reimbursement provided under Section 25-3-41. Legislative members 22 of the committee shall receive per diem, travel or other expenses, 23 if authorized by the Management Committees of the Senate and the 24 House of Representatives, from the contingent expense funds of 25 26 their respective houses in the same amounts as provided for committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session; provide 27
