## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 628

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF APRIL 2-8,  
2 2006, AS "JUNIOR AUXILIARY WEEK" IN MISSISSIPPI IN SUPPORT OF THE  
3 HUMANITARIAN AND CHARITABLE PROGRAMS OF THIS VOLUNTEER  
4 ORGANIZATION.

5 WHEREAS, the Junior Auxiliary Chapters in the State of  
6 Mississippi, members of the 65-year-old National Association of  
7 Junior Auxiliaries, Inc., represent a serious endeavor on the part  
8 of women to be active and constructive participants in their  
9 communities and to assume responsible leadership in meeting the  
10 needs of their communities; and

11 WHEREAS, the mission of the National Association of Junior  
12 Auxiliaries, Inc., is to encourage member chapters to render  
13 charitable services which are beneficial to the general public,  
14 with particular emphasis on children, and to cooperate with other  
15 organizations performing similar services; and

16 WHEREAS, Junior Auxiliary Chapters throughout Mississippi  
17 have been particularly active in Hurricane Katrina relief  
18 projects, which include volunteering thousands of hands-on service  
19 hours for general welfare programs and special needs. These  
20 programs provide clothing, food and medical care free of charge to  
21 Mississippi's neediest children, working closely with teachers,  
22 school nurses, counselors and social workers in our state, and  
23 reaching out to children and families in need; and

24 WHEREAS, the Junior Auxiliary Chapters of Mississippi work  
25 actively to perform the mission of the National Association of  
26 Junior Auxiliaries, Inc., in their communities and in the State of  
27 Mississippi, and we appreciate their efforts:

28           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
29 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That  
30 we do hereby designate the week of April 2-8, 2006, as "Junior  
31 Auxiliary Week" in Mississippi, as sponsored by the National  
32 Association of Junior Auxiliaries, Inc., and urge all citizens,  
33 all civic and fraternal groups, all news media, and other  
34 community organizations to join in the salute to Junior Auxiliary  
35 volunteers who have been an important presence in our state since
