- 3 WHEREAS, asthma has reached epidemic proportions in the
- 4 United States, affecting about 20 million people; and
- 5 WHEREAS, asthma is the leading cause of childhood
- 6 hospitalizations, long-term illness, and school absenteeism,
- 7 accounting for more than 14 million missed school days each year;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, each year two million people are rushed to the
- 10 emergency room and over 4,000 people die from asthma; and
- 11 WHEREAS, asthma is a long-term, inflammatory disease in which
- 12 the airways of the lungs constrict, causing wheezing,
- 13 breathlessness, chest tightness and coughing; and
