1 2 3	A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY BASEBALL COACH WILLIE "RAT" MCGOWAN, SR., THE DEAN OF BASEBALL COACHES IN THE SWAC.
4	WHEREAS, Willie "Rat" McGowan, Sr., a native of McComb,
5	Mississippi, has completed his 34th season as head baseball coach
6	of Alcorn State University with a record of 611-587-7; and
7	WHEREAS, an alumnus of Alcorn State University, Coach McGowan
8	earned his bachelor of science degree in health and physical
9	education in 1961, before furthering his education at the
10	Universities of Georgia and Kansas, while earning his master of
11	science in health and physical education from Kansas State
12	University; and
13	WHEREAS, while at Alcorn as a student, "Rat," a four-year
14	letterman in football, acted as the team captain during the 1960
15	and 1961 campaigns, and earned the Little All-American Award in
16	1958 during his freshman campaign, additionally receiving
17	All-Conference honors in each of his four seasons and named the
18	team's Most Valuable Player, while being the recipient of the
19	first Jack Spinks Award in 1959; and
20	WHEREAS, prior to graduating, McGowan became an instructor of
21	science at Central High School in Liberty, Mississippi, in
22	addition to being named assistant football coach before garnering
23	the titles of athletic director, head football coach, track and
24	field and baseball coach the ensuing year for the 1962-1964
25	seasons; and

WHEREAS, having shared his instructional and coaching

abilities and expertise in Mississippi and Missouri, "Rat" McGowan

- 28 made his way back to Alcorn in 1968 as defensive back coach, where
- 29 he remained part of the football staff until 1993; and
- 30 WHEREAS, over the course of his 25-year stint, he wore many
- 31 hats, helping to guide the Braves to nine Southwestern Athletic
- 32 Conference (SWAC) Championships and four National Black College
- 33 Championships; and
- 34 WHEREAS, in addition to his football coaching duties, McGowan
- 35 split duty as head baseball coach and earned four SWAC Coach of
- 36 the Year Awards (1976, 1979, 1981 and 1988), four Eastern Division
- 37 Championships and one Eastern Division Tournament Championship;
- 38 and
- 39 WHEREAS, "Rat" McGowan has coached several notable players
- 40 who have gone on to be drafted into the major league, continued
- 41 the tradition of grooming a solid pedigree of players with several
- 42 potential draft picks on the roster; and
- WHEREAS, in 1998, McGowan earned the prestigious honor of
- 44 being named to the Alcorn State University's Sports Hall of Fame
- 45 as a player and coach in football and baseball; and
- WHEREAS, known as the "Dean of Baseball Coaches" in the SWAC,
- 47 "Rat" is the eldest coach in the conference; and
- WHEREAS, wed to the former Doris Hamilton, who currently
- 49 serves as the Chair of the Department of Education and Psychology
- 50 at Alcorn, "Rat" has been supported and encouraged in his
- 51 endeavors by his wife and children, sons, Reginald and Willie,
- 52 Jr.; and
- 53 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the
- 54 landmark career of this coach who has brought honor to his
- 55 university and to the State of Mississippi:
