1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING CASEY ELEMENTARY 2 SCHOOL UPON THEIR RECEIPT OF THE ARTS IN EDUCATION AWARD CATEGORY 3 OF THE 2006 GOVERNOR'S AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE IN THE ARTS.

WHEREAS, Casey Elementary School in Jackson, Mississippi, is
the recipient of the Arts in Education Award Category of the 2006
Governor's Awards for Excellence in the Arts; and

7 WHEREAS, each of the 320 students at Casey Elementary School
8 is involved in exploring the arts, including visual art, music,
9 drama, dance and creative writing; and

10 WHEREAS, in the early 1990s, a group of parents became the 11 driving force behind bringing the arts to the school. Volunteer 12 teachers and parents were responsible for teaching the arts in the 13 classroom. A full-time teacher was hired in 1999, and now 14 teaching the regular curriculum through the arts is the school's 15 primary focus; and

16 WHEREAS, Casey was instrumental in obtaining a \$150,000.00 17 Ford Foundation Grant that enabled more than 2,500 students across 18 the district to experience learning through the arts; and

WHEREAS, the school has been nationally recognized as a Blue Ribbon School and was recently recognized by the Mississippi Arts Commission as one of four Model Schools in the state; and WHEREAS, the Jackson Public School District has provided funding for a full-time visual arts teacher and an arts facilitator because of the effect the arts have had on the school;

26 WHEREAS, since becoming a Whole School in 1999, Casey has 27 moved from a Level 3 to a Level 5, the highest level of 28 accreditation by the state; and

29 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize the 30 outstanding achievement by this public elementary school and its 31 students, teachers, administrators and parents, which have brought 32 honor to their community and to the State of Mississippi:

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF 34 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Casey 35 Elementary School in Jackson, Mississippi, upon their receipt of 36 the Arts in the Education Award Category of the 2006 Governor's 37 Awards for Excellence in the Arts, and extend to Casey's students, 38 teachers, administrators and parents the best wishes of the 39 Senate.
