SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 16

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND RECOGNIZING MR. BOB ANTHONY FOR
2 HAVING SPILLWAY ROAD AND RIVER VIEW PARKWAY NAMED IN HIS HONOR.

3 WHEREAS, on Friday, February 10, 2006, the Pearl River Valley
4 Water Supply District's Board of Directors will dedicate Spillway
5 Road and River View Parkway in Mr. Bob Anthony's honor, by
6 renaming it The Bob Anthony Parkway; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Anthony has been a longtime and outstanding
8 resident of Rankin County, Mississippi, who has willingly and
9 unselfishly given of his time, experience and expertise to his
10 community and fellow citizens; and

11 WHEREAS, Bob Anthony has provided invaluable counsel and
12 assistance to his community as a member of the Board of the Pearl
13 River Valley Water Supply District and Rankin First Economic
14 Development Authority, and as a member of the Board of the Pearl
15 River Valley Water Supply District he was instrumental in
16 procuring the monies necessary to construct the additional vehicle
17 lanes across the dam of the Ross Barnett Reservoir; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Anthony is widely respected by many people for
19 his leadership and contributions to his community and state, and
20 for his vision which allowed him to see the needs of the future
21 and to apply his efforts in a manner that most benefits his fellow
22 citizens; and

24 this outstanding Mississippian, whose actions have brought great
25 credit upon himself, Rankin County and the State of Mississippi:

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
27 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Mr. Bob

28 Anthony for having the Spillway Road and River View Parkway named
29 in his honor, and we extend to him our sincerest appreciation for
30 his service on behalf of his community and state and wish for him
31 every success in his future endeavors.
