1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING HONORABLE MARGARET
2 CAREY-MCCRAY UPON HER RECEIPT OF THE FANNIE LOU HAMER HUMAN RIGHTS
3 AWARD AS PART OF THE 5TH ANNUAL BLACK HISTORY MONTH CELEBRATION.

4 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Workers' Center for Human Rights
5 (the Center) marks Saturday, February 25, 2006, as its 5th Annual
6 Black History Month Celebration; and

7 WHEREAS, the theme of this year's celebration is "*Lift Every*
8 *Voice and Sing*" Celebrate 365 Days a Year; and

9 WHEREAS, on this day in honor of the life of Fannie Lou
10 Hamer, the Center is presenting the Fannie Lou Hamer Human Rights
11 Award to the Honorable Margaret Carey-McCray for her tireless work
12 as a litigator in the field of voting rights to ensure greater
13 access for those historically locked out of the democratic
14 process; and

15 WHEREAS, Judge McCray now serves with distinction as a
16 Circuit Court Judge in the Fourth Circuit District, which includes
17 Washington, Leflore and Sunflower Counties, Mississippi; and

18 WHEREAS, the Center expresses profound appreciation to
19 Margaret Carey-McCray for her support of its work and the
20 upliftment of the community as a whole:

22 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Honorable
