## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 100: Eminent Domain; restrict use of.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 11-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:
- 7 11-27-1. (1) Any person or corporation having the right to
- 8 condemn private property for public use shall exercise that right
- 9 as provided in this chapter, except as elsewhere specifically
- 10 provided under the laws of the State of Mississippi.
- 11 (2) Notwithstanding any provisions of this chapter to the
- 12 contrary or any other provisions of law to the contrary, private
- 13 property shall not be taken or damaged except for a direct public
- 14 use which is the predominate purpose of the taking or damage, and
- 15 due compensation is first made to the owner or owners thereof, in
- 16 the manner prescribed by law. An increase in tax revenue for a
- 17 governmental entity shall not be considered a direct public use.
- 18 Without limiting or enlarging what otherwise may or may not be a
- 19 direct public use, for purposes of this section, a direct public
- 20 use shall include drainage and levee facilities and usages; roads
- 21 and bridges for public conveyance; the preservation of an historic
- 22 structure listed on the National Register of Historic Places as
- 23 long as the condition of said structure constitutes a menace to
- 24 the public health and safety of the community and constitutes a
- 25 public hazard and nuisance as these phrases are used in Section
- 26 21-19-20(b)(1); and common carriers or facilities of public

- utilities and other entities used in the generation, transmission, 27
- storage or distribution of telephone, telecommunication, gas, 28
- carbon dioxide, electricity, water, sewer, natural gas, liquid 29
- 30 hydrocarbons or other utility products.
- 31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after its passage.
