REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 468: Distinctive license tags; authorize for various purposes.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

100 SECTION 1. In recognition of the patriotic service rendered 571 by Mississippians who are veterans of the United States Armed 572 Forces, any such person is privileged to obtain distinctive 573 motorcycle license plates or tags for each motorcycle registered 574 in his name identifying his status as a veteran.
