

## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 468: Distinctive license tags; authorize for various purposes.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

100        **SECTION 1.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a  
101 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws  
102 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon  
103 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes  
104 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of  
105 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,  
106 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount  
107 provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a  
108 special license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name  
109 identifying such person as a supporter of Support Our Troops, Inc.  
110 The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and  
111 design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of the Support  
112 Our Troops, Inc., may prescribe, and shall consist of such letters  
113 or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each  
114 license tag.

115        (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized  
116 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
117 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
118 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
119 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,  
120 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis

121 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional  
122 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the  
123 county general fund.

124 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or  
125 after July 1, 2006, any person applying for a distinctive license  
126 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount  
127 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag  
128 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all  
129 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a  
130 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established  
131 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the  
132 time the original application is made for a distinctive license  
133 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of  
134 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive  
135 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive  
136 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax  
137 collector.

138 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the  
139 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,  
140 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the  
141 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the  
142 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State  
143 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

144 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee  
145 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
146 section shall be disbursed to the Support Our Troops, Inc.

147 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
148 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
149 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant  
150 to Section 7-9-70.

151 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee  
152 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this

section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or reconstruction of highways.

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section 27-19-44.2.

(5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under this section. The tax collector shall issue month and year decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

(6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed proportionately in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this section.

**SECTION 2.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor

185 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a  
186 supporter of organ recovery. The distinctive license tags so  
187 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax  
188 Commission, with the advice of the Mississippi Organ Recovery  
189 Agency, may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or  
190 numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license  
191 tag.

192 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized  
193 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
194 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
195 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
196 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,  
197 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis  
198 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional  
199 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the  
200 county general fund.

201 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or  
202 after July 1, 2006, any person applying for a distinctive license  
203 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount  
204 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag  
205 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all  
206 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a  
207 period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established  
208 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the  
209 time the original application is made for a distinctive license  
210 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of  
211 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive  
212 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive  
213 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax  
214 collector.

215 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the  
216 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,

217 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the  
218 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the  
219 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State  
220 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

238 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as  
239 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under

242 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license  
243 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,  
244 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license  
245 tag.

246 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license  
247 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and  
248 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by

249 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license  
250 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving  
251 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and  
252 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee  
253 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be  
254 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular  
255 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

256       **SECTION 3.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a

278 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the

286 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag  
287 year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the  
288 original application is made for a distinctive license tag under  
289 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal  
290 registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license  
291 tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license  
292 tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector.

293           (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the  
294 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,  
295 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the  
296 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the  
297 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State  
298 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

299                   (a) Forty-four Dollars (\$44.00) of each additional fee  
300 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
301 section shall be disbursed to the Mississippi Children's Museum, a  
302 Mississippi nonprofit corporation.

303                   (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
304 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
305 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Center Fund created  
306 pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

307                   (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee  
308 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
309 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund  
310 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or  
311 reconstruction of highways.

312           (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected  
313 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall  
314 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section  
315 27-19-44.2.

316           (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as

350 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms  
351 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the  
352 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less  
353 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,  
354 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis  
355 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional

565 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee  
566 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be

567 distributed proportionately in the same manner as funds from the  
568 sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this  
569 section.

570       **SECTION 7.** In recognition of the patriotic service rendered  
571 by Mississippians who are veterans of the United States Armed  
572 Forces, any such person is privileged to obtain distinctive  
573 motorcycle license plates or tags for each motorcycle registered  
574 in his name identifying his status as a veteran. The State Tax  
575 Commission, with concurrence by the State Veterans Affairs Board,  
576 shall develop decals to be affixed to the license tag indicating  
577 branch and period of military service. The distinctive plates or  
578 tags shall be of a color and design designated by the Tax  
579 Commission with concurrence by the State Veterans Affairs Board.

580       The distinctive license plates shall be prepared by the Tax  
581 Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the  
582 counties in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license  
583 plates or tags. An additional annual tag fee of Thirty Dollars  
584 (\$30.00) shall be collected by the tax collector for such license  
585 plates or tags and shall be remitted to the Tax Commission on a  
586 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The additional fee  
587 is due and payable at the time the original application is made  
588 for a distinctive tag under this section and thereafter annually  
589 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains  
590 the distinctive license tag. The State Tax Commission shall  
591 deposit such fee to the credit of a fund to be administered by the  
592 board overseeing the veterans nursing homes in this state for the  
593 benefit of indigent veterans who are residents of such nursing  
594 homes.

595       An applicant for the distinctive plates shall present to the  
596 issuing official written evidence of the veteran's service. The  
597 evidence shall include a copy of the applicant's DD-214 form, a  
598 Report of Separation from Military Service, a military discharge



599 document, a written certification of military service from the  
600 State Veterans Affairs Board or a valid military identification  
601 card; however, a distinctive license plate or tag shall not be  
602 issued under this section to any person who was dishonorably  
603 discharged from the United States Armed Forces. The distinctive  
604 license plates or tags so issued shall be used only upon a  
605 personally or jointly owned private motorcycle registered in the  
606 name, or jointly in the name, of the person making the  
607 application, and when issued to the person shall be used upon the  
608 motorcycle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plate  
609 or license tag normally issued for the motorcycle.

610 The distinctive license plates shall not be transferable  
611 between motorcycle owners; and in the event the owner of a  
612 motorcycle bearing a distinctive plate shall sell, trade, exchange  
613 or otherwise dispose of the motorcycle, the plate shall be  
614 retained by the owner and returned to the tax collector.

615 **SECTION 8.** Section 27-19-56.15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
616 amended as follows:

617 27-19-56.15. (1) (a) Beginning with any registration year  
618 commencing on or after July 1, 2006, any owner of a motor vehicle

640 retained by the tax collector, shall be remitted to the State Tax

644 (d) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees  
645 that it receives under this subsection into the State Treasury on

660 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or

662                    (iv) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee  
663 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this  
664 section shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund  
665 created in Section 27-19-44.2.

666            (2) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as  
667 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under  
668 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the  
669 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under  
670 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license  
671 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,

674            (3) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license

684            (4) In order for a distinctive license tag for a university  
685 to be issued pursuant to this section, the provisions of Section  
686 27-19-44(2) must be satisfied for such university license tag  
687 prior to July 1, 2009.

688            **SECTION 9.** Section 27-19-56.41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
689 amended as follows:

690            27-19-56.41. (1) Beginning with any registration year  
691 commencing on or after July 1, 2006, any owner of a motor vehicle
