REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 991: Public property; authorize DFA to sell property known as State School for the Blind.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. (1) There is created a joint committee of the 12 Legislature for the purpose of studying development possibilities 13 14 and alternatives for the real property owned by the State of Mississippi and formerly occupied by the Mississippi School for 15 16 the Blind. The joint committee shall consider the best interests 17 of nearby neighborhoods, the Mississippi School for the Blind and 18 preservation thereof in making its report. The joint committee shall also study and consider the disposal of any state property 19 20 determined by the Department of Finance and Administration to be surplus property. The joint committee shall be composed of five 21 22 (5) members of the House of Representatives appointed by the 23 Speaker of the House and five (5) members appointed by the The joint committee shall report to the 24 Lieutenant Governor. 25 House of Representatives and the Senate by January 5, 2007, as to 26 its findings and upon presentation of such report the joint 27 committee shall be dissolved.

Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after the enactment of this act; and, within fifteen (15) days thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House, the committee shall meet and organize by selecting from its membership a chairman and a vice chairman. The

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(H)PP (S)PP;FI G1/2 33 vice chairman shall also serve as secretary and shall be 34 responsible for keeping all records of the committee. A majority 35 of the members of the committee shall constitute a quorum. In the selection of its officers and the adoption of rules, resolutions 36 37 and reports, an affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the joint committee from each house shall be required. All 38 39 members shall be notified in writing of all meetings, such notices 40 to be mailed at least five (5) days prior to the date on which a meeting is to be held. Members of the committee shall be paid 41 42 from the contingent expense funds of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for committee meetings when the 43 44 Legislature is not in session.

45 (2) No action shall be taken with respect to any sale, lease
46 or development of the real property described in subsection (1) of
47 this section without specific legislative act.

48 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The Department of Finance and Administration is 49 authorized to assign to the State Department of Health certain 50 state-owned property known as the "Old Veterinary Diagnostics 51 Building" located at 2531 North West Street in the City of 52 Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi, until completion and occupancy 53 of the new health facility.

54 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 55 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
