## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1235: Medical records affidavits; limit amount medical providers may charge.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. Section 11-1-52, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 11-1-52. (1) Any medical provider or hospital or nursing
- home or other medical facility shall charge no more than the 8
- 9 following amounts to patients or their representatives for
- 10 photocopying any patient's records: Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
- pages one (1) through twenty (20); One Dollar (\$1.00) per page for 11
- the next eighty (80) pages; Fifty Cents (50¢) per page for all 12
- 13 pages thereafter. Ten percent (10%) of the total charge may be
- 14 added for postage and handling. Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) may be
- 15 recovered by the medical provider or hospital or nursing home or
- 16 other medical facility for retrieving medical records in archives
- 17 at a location off the premises where the facility/office is
- 18 located.
- (2) A physician shall only charge normal, reasonable and 19
- 20 customary charges for a deposition related to a patient that the
- physician is treating or has treated. 21
- (3) Any medical provider, hospital, nursing home or other 22
- 23 medical facility shall charge no more than Twenty-five Dollars
- (\$25.00) for executing a medical record affidavit, when the 24

- 25 affidavit is requested by the patient or the patient's
- 26 representative.
- (4) In charging the fees authorized under subsection (1) of 27
- 28 this section, the medical provider, hospital, nursing home or
- 29 other medical facility shall comply with the federal Health
- Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). 30
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31
- 32 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-1-52, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 LIMIT THE AMOUNT MEDICAL PROVIDERS CAN CHARGE FOR A MEDICAL RECORD AFFIDAVIT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
