## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1564: Appropriation; State Department of Healthsupport.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
10	\$ 32,664,735.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department
14	of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by
15	or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
18	\$ 237,803,382.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Sections 1 and 2, Two Million Seven Hundred Three Thousand
21	Ninety-four Dollars (\$2,703,094.00) shall be derived from the
22	State General Fund and Nine Million Eight Hundred Fifty-nine
23	Thousand Five Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$9,859,513.00) shall be
24	derived from the Health Care Expendable Fund, created in Section
25	43-13-407, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and

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26	maintenance of the State Department of Health. The funds provided
27	in this section shall be allocated as follows:

43	(\$5,326,901.00) authorized herein for the Trauma Care System shall
44	be expended to the benefit of any hospital located outside the
45	boundaries of the State of Mississippi, unless otherwise excepted
46	in this paragraph. Further, unless otherwise excepted in this
47	paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be authorized to
48	receive such funds until such time as the amount appropriated for
49	such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight Million Dollars
50	(\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended by the
51	Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the Regional
52	Medical Center at Memphis, located in Memphis, Tennessee, for
53	their participation in the Trauma Care System.
54	SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
55	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
56	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
57	expenditure:

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     approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
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     without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the

     act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
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          SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
     State Department of Health shall maintain complete accounting and
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personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

204	SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
205	Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of
206	Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate
207	special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. These
208	funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no
209	later than July 31, 2006. The State Department of Health shall
210	make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the
211	Department of Human Services.
212	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
213	State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty
214	Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section
215	1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as
216	"Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder
217	adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents

- over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder
  adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the
  cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed
  pathology and biannual MRI exams.

  SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore
- appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
  necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in
  the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as
  authorized in the case Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State
  of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery
  Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the
  State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning
- July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007...... \$ 5,000,000.00.

  It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds

  appropriated in this section, an amount not less than Two Million
- Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund the School Tobacco Nurse Program.
- SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven
  Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) are provided for the
  purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and other necessary AIDS related
  medical services.
- 239 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, 240 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be provided to the 241 Southern AIDS Commission, Inc., for the purpose of providing 242 technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education 243 on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery services to persons infected with HIV. The Southern AIDS 244 245 Commission, Inc. shall report by February 1, 2007, to the Board of Health and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health 246 247 Committees the status of the project and all services provided.
- 248 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 249 and allocated in Section 3, the amounts of One Hundred Ten

250	Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be
251	allocated to the T.K. Martin Center at Mississippi State
252	University and One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven
253	Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the Regional
254	Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention
255	Program.
256	SECTION 16. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand
257	Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Breast and Cervical
258	Cancer Program.
259	SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
260	Executive Director of the State Department of Health may authorize
261	increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to
262	exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of
263	each major object of expenditure, provided that other major
264	objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar
265	amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase
266	the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe
267	Benefits."
268	SECTION 18. In addition to all other funds heretofore
269	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
270	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
271	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Burn Care Fund which is
272	comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise
273	available to the department, for the purpose of funding the
274	development of a plan for delivery of services and of providing
275	reimbursement for uncompensated medical care to Mississippi burn
276	victims through the trauma care system, for the fiscal year
277	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
278	\$3,000,000.00.
279	The State Department of Health shall issue any certificates
280	of need necessary to any person proposing the construction of,
281	addition of, or conversion of any beds or the expansion of any

283 victims, and such beds shall be classified and limited to use for 284 such treatment of burn victims and may not be converted to any 285 other use and are not to be classified or included in the acute care bed inventory of the state for health planning purposes. 286 287 such beds shall participate in the statewide trauma care system as provided by Section 41-59-5 and be entitled to an allocation of 288 289 funds from the Mississippi Burn Care Fund as established by 290 Section 7-9-70. For purposes of this subsection, the provisions 291 of Section 41-7-193(1) requiring substantial compliance with the 292 projection of need as reported in the current State Health Plan 293 are waived. 294 SECTION 19. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, 295 Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) shall be provided to the North Mississippi Prevention Center, for the purpose of providing 296 297 technical assistance, and providing for the expansion of education 298 on causes and prevention of HIV/AIDS, and providing delivery services to persons infected with HIV. The North Mississippi 299 300 Prevention Center, shall report by February 1, 2007, to the Board 301 of Health and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Public Health 302 Committees the status of the project and all services provided. 303 SECTION 20. It is the intention of the Legislature that 304 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 305 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 306 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 307 308 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 309 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 310 made without competitive bids. 311 SECTION 21. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 312 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

health care facility for use exclusively for the treatment of burn

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

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314 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 315

316 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 22. This act shall take effect and be in force from 317

318 and after July 1, 2006.
