REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1568: Appropriation; Department of Archives and History.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of

16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that

94	SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and

100	regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a

104	maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with
105	the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these

222	Archives and History for the purpose of supporting the Statewide
223	Oral History Project for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006,
224	and ending June 30, 2007 \$ 150,000.00.
225	SECTION 15. Of the funds in Section 1, a sum not to exceed
226	Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) is provided as matching
227	funds for a Preserve America Grant to fund research and workshops
228	on how to rebuild the Gulf Coast's Heritage Tourism Industry after
229	Hurricane Katrina.

SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
