REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1569: Appropriation; Arts Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
10	\$ 1,158,383.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts
14	Commission which is comprised of special source funds and
15	donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for
17	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.
18	\$ 1,645,214.00.
19	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
20	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:
21	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
22	Permanent: Full Time
23	Part Time0
24	Time-Limited: Full Time
25	Part Time0

26	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
27	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
28	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
29	Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater,
30	with not more than one-half $(1/2)$ to be awarded on July 1, 2006,
31	with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.
32	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
33	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
34	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
35	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
36	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
37	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
38	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
39	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
40	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
41	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
42	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
43	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
44	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
45	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
46	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
47	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
48	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
49	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
50	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
51	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
52	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
53	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
54	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
55	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
56	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
57	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written

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58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
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- 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 62 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 64 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 65 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 66 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 67 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 68 Mississippi Arts Commission shall maintain complete accounting and
- 69 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 70 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 71 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 72 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 73 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
- 74 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 75 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 76 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- 77 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 78 Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand
- 79 Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education
- 80 Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31,
- 81 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following:
- Training of educators and promotion
- of arts programs in public schools . . . \$100,000.00
- Miscellaneous grants and programs \$350,000.00
- 85 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 86 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars
- 87 appropriated herein designated for the "Challenge Program,"
- 88 specific amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called
- 89 the Arts Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended

- amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall 90 91 not lapse into the State General Fund and may be expended by the 92 commission in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the 93 Legislature. Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited 94 to the credit of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission 95 upon appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of 96 the Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 97 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of 98 99 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.
- 100 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate 101 102 its budget and expend funds from any source available not to 103 exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), that may 104 become available to the commission in accordance with the rules 105 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 106 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.
- SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that 107 108 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 109 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 110 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 111 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 112 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 113 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 114 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 115 116 Section 2, Two Hundred Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-two Dollars (\$217,822.00) shall be derived from the Budget Contingency 117 Fund created in Section 27-103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, for 118 119 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Arts 120 Commission.

SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
