REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1574: Appropriation; Insurance Department.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 74 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Mississippi Department of Insurance shall maintain complete
- 76 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 77 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 78 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 79 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 80 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be
- 81 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 82 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 83 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 85 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, Fifteen
- 86 Thousand Seventy-nine Dollars (\$15,079.00) is provided for the
- 87 Mississippi Fire Personnel Minimum Standards and Certification
- 88 Board.
- 89 **SECTION 5.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 90 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special

91	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Rural Fire Truck
92	Acquisition Fund to the Mississippi Department of Insurance for
93	the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance Program for the fiscal
94	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
95	\$ 5,093,191.00.
96	SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
97	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
98	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Supplemental Rural
99	Fire Truck Fund, created in Section 1, Laws of 2004, Third
L00	Extraordinary Session, to the Mississippi Department of Insurance
L01	for the Supplemental Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance
L02	Program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
L03	June 30, 2007\$ 2,600,000.00
L04	SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
L05	Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, funds in
L06	the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) are provided and
L07	shall be expended to pay the annual dues for the National
L08	Conference of Insurance Legislators.
L09	SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that none
L10	of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members
L11	of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate
L12	are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony
L13	announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public
L14	announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening
L15	of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has
L16	made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or
L17	any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following
L18	language: "Funds were made available for this project by the
L19	Mississippi State Legislature."
L20	SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that
L21	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
L22	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 123 124 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 125 126 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

127 made without competitive bids.

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SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

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SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from
