REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1575: Appropriation; State Fire Academy.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy Fund, for the
7	purpose of defraying the expenses of the academy for the fiscal
8	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
9	\$ 4,623,644.00.
10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
12	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
13	expenditure:

16	Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits \$ 3,335,652.00

30	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
31	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
32	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
33	Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater,
34	with not more than one-half $(1/2)$ to be awarded on July 1, 2006,
35	with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.
36	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
37	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
38	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
39	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
40	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
41	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
42	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
43	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
44	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
45	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
46	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
47	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
48	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
49	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
50	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
51	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
52	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
53	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
54	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
55	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
56	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
57	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 58
- 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 60
- 61 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 62 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 63 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 65
- 66 appropriated level.
- 67 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 68
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 69
- 70 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 71
- 72 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and
- 73 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 74 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 75
- 76 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
- 78 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 79 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 80 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- 81 It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 82 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend
- funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 83
- 84 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the
- agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the 85
- Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 86
- 87 with the escalation of federal funds.
- SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 88
- 89 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90

stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 91

quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 92

93 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

94 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

95 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 96

97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 98

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 101

102 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

103 and after July 1, 2006.
