REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1589: Appropriation; Pearl River Valley Water Supply District.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, with not more than one-half (1/2) to be awarded on July 1, 2006, with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 39 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 41 42 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 43 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 45 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 49 50 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 51 52 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 53 54 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 55 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 56 57 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

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60 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 61 62 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 63 64 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 65 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 66 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 68

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

With the funds herein appropriated, funds are included and authorized in the Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits major object of expenditure to pay "call back pay" in lieu of "compensatory time credit," at the discretion of the Director of the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, to any employee who must work on a statutory holiday or any holiday proclaimed by the Governor.

79 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 80 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 81 82 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 83 84 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 85 86 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 87 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 88

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SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 89 90 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 91 92 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 93 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 94 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 95 96 made without competitive bids.

97 SECTION 5. The funds herein approved for expenditure, except 98 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which 99 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations, shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the 100 101 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent 102 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills 103 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

104 SECTION 6. The Pearl River Valley Water Supply District is 105 authorized to expend any federal or state funds to repair damage caused by Hurricane Katrina on the shoreline located between the 106 107 Bob Anthony Parkway and the causeway on either public or private 108 property.

109 SECTION 7. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 110 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 111 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with 112 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 113 114 and after July 1, 2006.
