## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1590: Appropriation; Board of Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family Therapists.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be

- Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 66
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 67
- 68 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- appropriated level. 69
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 70
- 71 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 72 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 73
- 74 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Board of Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family
- 76 Therapists shall maintain complete accounting and personnel
- 77 records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under
- 78 this act and that such records shall be in the same format and
- level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. 79 It is further
- 80 the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request
- 81 for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 82
- 83 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007
- 84 budget request process.
- 85 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 86
- purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 87
- 88 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 89 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 90 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

91 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

92 made without competitive bids.

93 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

94 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

95 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

96 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

97 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

98 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

99 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

100 and after July 1, 2006.
