REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 2589: Appropriation; transfer certain funds into Budget Contingency Fund.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer to the 13
- Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, from the 14
- 15 State General Fund, an amount equal to One Hundred Sixty-five
- Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$165,200,000.00) for the 16
- 17 period beginning upon the passage of this act through June 30,
- 18 2006.
- The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer to the 19
- Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, from the 2.0
- 21 State General Fund, an amount equal to Thirty-seven Million Two
- Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$37,240,000.00) during the period 22
- 23 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.
- 24 SECTION 3. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
- special fund, separate and apart from any other special fund, to 25
- 26 be designated as the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund. The State
- Fiscal Officer shall transfer from the State General Fund into the 2.7
- 2.8 Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund an amount equal to Two Hundred
- Sixty-eight Million Dollars (\$268,000,000.00) during the period 29
- beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007. 30
- 31 The funds transferred herein to the Hurricane Disaster
- Reserve Fund shall be utilized to defray the state's share of any 32
- 33 nonfederal matching requirements for Federal Emergency Management

- 34 Agency grants associated with Hurricane Katrina and other
- 35 disasters. Unexpended funds remaining in the Hurricane Disaster
- 36 Reserve Fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse into
- 37 the State General Fund but shall remain in the fund and any
- 38 interest earned on the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund shall
- 39 remain in the fund.
- Funds deposited into the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund 40
- 41 shall be used only for the purposes specified in this section, and
- as long as the provisions of this section remain in effect, no 42
- 43 other expenditure, appropriation or transfer of funds in the
- 44 Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund shall be made except by act of the
- Legislature making specific reference to the Hurricane Disaster 45
- Reserve Fund as the source of those funds. 46
- SECTION 4. Section 12, Chapter 112, Laws of the Second 47
- Extraordinary Session of 2005, is amended as follows: 48
- 49 Section 12. The Department of Finance and Administration
- 50 shall transfer rent funds to the General Fund in an amount not
- 51 less than Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00).
- 52 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Public Employees' Retirement
- 53 System shall transfer from Fund Number 3531 to the Budget
- 54 Contingency Fund not later than August 31, 2006, any remaining
- 55 balance as of June 30, 2006, of the Fifty Million Dollars
- 56 (\$50,000,000.00) of General Funds transferred to and utilized by
- 57 the system as a credit against the one percent (1%) increase in
- 58 General Fund employer contributions beginning July 1, 2005,
- pursuant to House Bill No. 1 of the Second Extraordinary Session 59
- of 2005. 60
- SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 61
- 62 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER STATE GENERAL FUNDS INTO THE BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUND DURING FISCAL YEARS 2006 AND 2007; TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE HURRICANE DISASTER RESERVE FUND AND TO DIRECT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER STATE GENERAL FUNDS INTO THE HURRICANE DISASTER RESERVE FUND; TO AMEND SECTION 12, CHAPTER 112, LAWS OF THE SECOND EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF 2005, TO REVISE THE AMOUNT OF RENT FUNDS TO BE TRANSFERRED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION; TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM TO TRANSFER CERTAIN FUNDS TO THE BUDGET CONTINGENCY FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
