## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3006: Appropriation; Ethics Comm.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. Th	e following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State	
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of	
7	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Ethics Commission for	
8	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

10	SECTION 2. Th	e following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereb	y appropriated out of any money in the Budget
12	Contingency Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of	
13	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Ethics Commission for	
14	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30,	
15	2007	\$ 16,000.00.
16	SECTION 3. Wi	th the funds appropriated under the provisions
17	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

23	Any transfers	or escalations shall be made in accordance with
24	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.	

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 25 26 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 27 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 28
- 29 It is the intention of the Legislature that the 30 Mississippi Ethics Commission shall maintain complete accounting 31 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 32 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 33 34 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 35 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 36 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 37

during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

- 39 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 40 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 41 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 42 43 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 44 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 45 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 46 made without competitive bids.
- 47 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 48 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 49 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 50 51 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

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52 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 53

54 and after July 1, 2006.
