We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of 8 9 Audit in making the audits and investigations of public offices of 10 the state and counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 11 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 6,036,065.00. 12 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special funds in the 14 15 State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Audit's 16 special fund account for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of Audit in making 17 the audits and investigations of public offices of the state and 18 counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., Mississippi Code 19 20 of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 21 June 30, 2007.....\$ 22 SECTION 3. - Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 78 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 79 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 80 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 81 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 82
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 83 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 84 85 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 86
- 87 SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 88 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 89 90 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

114	with the Single Audit Act of 1984. These special funds may be
115	used to employ staff, and pay related expenses, or to engage
116	private accountants, as necessary, to comply with the provisions

118	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that
119	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
120	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

- 137 Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
- 138 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
- 139 media expenditures.
- (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 140
- 141 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 142 State Department of Audit is hereby authorized to escalate
- positions not to exceed ten (10), to escalate budget and expend 143
- 144 funds from any source, for the purpose of auditing emergency
- 145 United States Housing and Urban Development grants related to
- 146 Hurricane Katrina, not to exceed One Million Dollars
- 147 (\$1,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the
- 148 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- with the escalation of federal funds. 149
- 150 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 151
- 152 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 153

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 154

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 155

SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 156

and after July 1, 2006, except for Section 8 which shall take 157

158 effect and be in force from and after its passage.
