S. B. No. 3012: Appropriation; Treasurers Office.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

193	SECTION 13. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall
194	be used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of said
195	funds be used either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of
196	paying any clerk, stenographer, assistant, deputy or other person
197	who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree,
198	computed by the rules of the civil law, to the official employing
199	or having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the
200	event of any such payment, then the official or person approving
201	and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and
202	severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay
203	into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or
204	received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General;
205	provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person
206	through whom the relationship was established is dead, this
207	provision shall not apply.
208	SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
209	Office of the State Treasurer shall maintain complete accounting
210	and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
211	appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such
212	records shall be in the same format and level of details as
213	maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of
214	the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall
215	be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
216	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
217	provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

218	SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
219	State Treasurer's Office may authorize increases in major objects
220	of expenditure in total amounts not to exceed fifteen percent
221	(15%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of
222	expenditure, provided that other major objects of expenditure are
223	decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers
224	shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
225	"Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

SECTION 17. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

240 SECTION 18. This act shall take effect and be in force from 241 and after July 1, 2006.
