REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- S. B. No. 3016: Appropriation; Forest & Wildlife Research.
 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of paying 8 9 the expenses incurred in the operation and maintenance of the Forest and Wildlife Research Center for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007......\$ 11 4,774,868.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available 14 15 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Forest and Wildlife Research Center, for the fiscal year beginning 16 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... \$ 1,095,258.00. 17 SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 18 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds 19 20 which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 21 22 It is the intention of the Legislature that if 23 the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly 2.4 or indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants, research grants or donations, such special source funds not 25 classified as restricted funds shall be added and accounted for 26

- under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the intention of the 27
- 28 Legislature that all such aforementioned special source funds be
- 29 included in all reports and requests for the 2007 Regular Session
- 30 of the Mississippi Legislature.
- 31 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 32
- 33 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 34
- during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 35
- 36 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two
- 37 Hundred Seventy-six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-three Dollars
- (\$276,253.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund 38
- from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 39
- 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972. 40
- SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that 41
- 42 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 43 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 44
- 45 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 46 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 47 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 48 made without competitive bids.
- 49 SECTION 8. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 50 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible.
- 51 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner. 52
- 53 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- the following criteria: 54
- 55 Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 56 Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising
- standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness. 57

- (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired 58 59 by media without cost.
- Itemize and justify professional assistance and related 60 61 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual 62 media expenditures.
- (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 63

SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 64 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 65 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 66 67 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 68 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 69

70 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006. 71
