REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3024: Appropriation; Gaming Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

| 18 | SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of |
| 19 | Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below |
| 20 | shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of |
| 21 | expenditure: |

| 57 | appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this |
| 58 | act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure |

- 59 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 60 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 61 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 62
- 63 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 64 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 65
- 66 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 67 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 68 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 69
- 70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 72 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 73
- 74 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 75 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 76 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 77 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 78 appropriated level.
- 79 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 80 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 81 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 82
- 83 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be 84
- 85 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a
- nonprofit organization. 86
- SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 87
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 88
- purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 89
- 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 91

92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 93

94 made without competitive bids.

95 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

96 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 97

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 98

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

101 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

102 and after July 1, 2006.
