## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3024: Appropriation; Gaming Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

16	Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending

18	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
19	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, with not more than one-half (1/2) to be awarded on July 1, 2006, with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.

48 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 49 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 50 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 51 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 52 53 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 54 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 55 56 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 57 58 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

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59 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 60 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 61 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 62 63 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 64 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 65 66 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 67 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 68 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 69

70 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 71 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 72 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 73 74 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 75 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 76 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 77 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 78 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

83 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 84 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be 85 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a 86 nonprofit organization.

87 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

A similar preference shall be given to 93 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 94 made without competitive bids.

95 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 96 Section 2, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be 97 derived from the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-98 103-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying 99 the expenses of the Gaming Commission.

100 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 101 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 102 103 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 104 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 105 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 106 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 107 and after July 1, 2006.
