 - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
 - That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
 - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as				
7	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the				
8	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission				
9	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Mississippi Fair

- requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 60

- 62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 63 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

- 65 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 66 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 67 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68
- 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the

- 71 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 72 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 73 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

- 75 SECTION 3. No operation, maintenance or service contracts,
- 76 agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or
- 77 catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency
- for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said 78
- 79 contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance
- 80 with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi
- 81 Code of 1972.
- 82 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of 83
- 84 the Legislature that Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) shall be
- transferred to the Fair Commission County Livestock Shows during 85
- the Fiscal Year 2007. 86
- SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 87
- 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 90
- 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 92
- 93 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 94 made without competitive bids.
- 95 SECTION 6. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 96 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,
- 97 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- 98 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner.
- 99 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- the following criteria: 100
- 101 (1) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 102 Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising
- standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness. 103
- 104 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired
- 105 by media without cost.
- 106 Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
- 107 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
- 108 media expenditures.
- (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 109
- 110 SECTION 7. Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 111 this act, Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) is provided to
- 112 reclassify PIN #6 from a Branch Director I to a Branch Director
- 113 TT.
- 114 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 115 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 116 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 117
- 118 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 119
- SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 120
- 121 and after July 1, 2006, except for Section 6 which shall take
- effect and be in force from and after its passage. 122

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
