## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3042: Appropriation; Bd. of Architecture.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State	
7	Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Architecture and	
8	Landscape Architecture Advisory Committee, for the purpose of	
9	defraying the expenses incurred by said board for the fiscal year	
10	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007	
11	\$ 287,601.00.	
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions	
13	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:	
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:	
15	Permanent: Full Time 2	
16	Part Time 0	
17	Time-Limited: Full Time	
18	Part Time 0	
19	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation	
20	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase	
21	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation	
22	Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater,	
23	with not more than one-half $(1/2)$ to be awarded on July 1, 2006,	
24	with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.	
25	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of	
26	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to	
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27 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 28 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 29 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 30 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 31 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 35 act. 36 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 39 40 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 41 42 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 43 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 44 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 45 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 46 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

47 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 48 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 49 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 50 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 51 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 52 53 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 54 55 appropriated level.

56 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 58 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 60 61 Board of Architecture shall maintain complete accounting and 62 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 63 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 64 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 65 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 66 67 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 68 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 69

70 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 71 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 72 73 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 74 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 75 76 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 77 made without competitive bids.

**SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

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83 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

84 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2006. 85
