## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3043: Appropriation; Banking and Consumer Finance.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Banking
8	and Consumer Finance, for the support of the State Department of
9	Banking and Consumer Finance, for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
11	\$ 6,112,096.00.
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
13	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 59
16	Part Time 0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
18	Part Time 0
19	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
20	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
21	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
22	Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater,
23	with not more than one-half $(1/2)$ to be awarded on July 1, 2006,
24	with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.
25	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
26	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
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- 27 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
- 28 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
- 29 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
- 30 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
- Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 31
- 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 35
- 36 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 37
- Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 38
- If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 39
- 40 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 41
- 42 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 43 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 44 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 45 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 46 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 47 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 48 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 49 allowable under the terms set forth within this act.
- 50 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 51 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 52
- 53 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 54
- 55 appropriated level.
- 56 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 58
- 59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 60
- 61 Banking and Consumer Finance shall maintain complete accounting
- 62 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 63 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 64
- 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 65
- agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 66
- 67 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 68
- during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 69
- 70 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 71
- purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 72
- 73 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 74 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 75
- 76 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 77 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 78
- 79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 80 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 81
- 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

83 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84

85 and after July 1, 2006.
