We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3045: Appropriation; Dental Examiners Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 58

- 62 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 63 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 64
- without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 65

- 67 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 68
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 69
- 70 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 71
- of the funds appropriated in this act shall be authorized for the 72
- 73 purchase of surveillance equipment.
- 74 It is the intention of the Legislature that
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 75
- 76 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 77 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 78 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 79 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 80 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- made without competitive bids. 81
- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 82
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 83
- 84 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 85
- 86 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

87 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 88

89 and after July 1, 2006.
