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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3050: Appropriation; Motor Vehicle Comm.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 85
- 86 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the

- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 88
- 89 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90

stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 91

quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 92

93 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

94 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

95 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 96

97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 98

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 101

102 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

103 and after July 1, 2006.
