REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3055: Appropriation; Office of State Aid Road Construction.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, with not more than one-half (1/2) to be awarded on July 1, 2006, with the remainder to be awarded on January 1, 2007.

42 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 44 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 45 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 46 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 47 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 48 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 49 50 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 51 52 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 54 55 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 56 57 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency

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64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 66 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 68 The 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

77 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 78 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete 79 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 80 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 81 82 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 83 84 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 85 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 86

87 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 88 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to 89 accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the

office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00) 90 91 for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges 92 on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in 93 accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as 94 established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 95 expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth 96 by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the State Fiscal Officer. 97

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 98 99 act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction is authorized to 100 reimburse Adams County in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand 101 Dollars (\$500,000.00) from unobligated State Aid Road funds 102 allocated to Adams County for the 2004 - 2007 term of office of members of the board of supervisors to match federal aid funds of 103 104 the Surface Transportation Program administered by the Mississippi 105 Department of Transportation for the project known as Government 106 Fleet Road Extension that is designated as the Intermodal 107 Connector Route 83, Adams County, Mississippi.

108 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 109 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 110 of the Mississippi Senate and House of Representatives are 111 notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 112 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 113 114 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 115 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 116 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 117 118 Mississippi State Legislature."

119 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 120 Office of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and 121 expend funds not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars

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(\$300,000.00) out of funds received from the Mississippi 122 123 Development Authority as reimbursement for actual expenses 124 incurred by the Office of State Aid Road Construction for 125 administering and providing engineering services to political 126 subdivisions as authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code 127 of 1972, subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations 128 of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. Any escalated 129 funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads 130 131 Administrative Fund, a special fund hereby created in the State Treasury, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 132 June 30, 2007. 133

SECTION 8. The office of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall be exempt from any transfer of special funds into the State General Fund or the Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, that is directed or authorized by the Department of Finance and Administration or by the State Treasurer.

140 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 141 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 142 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 143 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 144 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 145 146 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 147 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
