House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2432

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as 7 Section 3-3-15.1, Mississippi Code of 1972: 3-3-15.1. (1) The Legislature enacts this section as the 8 symbol of the nation's and the state's commitment to achieving the 9 fullest possible accounting for Mississippians who have been or in 10 11 the future may become prisoners of war, missing in action or 12 otherwise unaccounted for as a result of hostile action. (2) As used in this section, the term "POW/MIA Flag" means 13 14 the National League of Families POW/MIA flag recognized officially 15 and designated by Section 2 of Public Law 101-355 (36 USCS Section 189). 16 17 (3) The Bureau of Capitol Facilities shall display the 18 POW/MIA flag in a prominent place at the New Capitol Building on the following days: 19 Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday in May;

- 21 Memorial Day, the last Monday in May; (b)
- Flag Day, June 14; 22 (C)
- 23 (d) Independence Day, July 4;
- National POW/MIA Recognition Day; and 24 (e)
- 25 (f) Veterans Day, November 11.
- Such display shall serve as the symbol of the nation's 26
- and the state's concern and commitment to achieving the fullest 27
- 28 possible accounting of Americans and Mississippians who, having
- been prisoners of war or missing in action, still remain 29
- unaccounted for. 30

- 31 (5) This section shall not be construed or applied so as to
- 32 either require or prohibit the display of the POW/MIA flag by any
- 33 county, municipality or public school district in Mississippi.
- 34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 3-3-15.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DIRECT THE BUREAU OF CAPITOL FACILITIES TO DISPLAY THE POW/MIA FLAG AT THE NEW CAPITOL BUILDING ON CERTAIN DAYS RELATING TO THE RECOGNITION OF VETERANS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
