## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2581

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

S. B. 2581 PAGE 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 Section 27-103-129, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 8 27-103-129. (1) To enable the Legislative Budget Office to 9 prepare such budget, it shall have full and plenary power and authority to require all general-fund and special-fund agencies 10 11 and the Mississippi Department of Transportation and the Division 12 of State Aid Road Construction of the Mississippi Department of Transportation to file a budget request with such information and 13 14 in such form and in such detail as it may deem necessary and 15 advisable, and it shall have the further power and authority to reduce or eliminate any item or items of requested appropriation 16 17 by any state agency in the Legislative Budget Office's recommended 18 budget to the Legislature. However, where any item of requested appropriation shall be so reduced or eliminated, the head of the 19 20 agency involved shall have the right to appear before the 21 appropriate legislative committee to urge a revision of the budget to restore the item reduced or eliminated. Beginning with the 22 23 1996 fiscal year, the budget requests shall include a definition of the mission of the agency, a description of the duties and 24 25 responsibilities of the agency, financial data relative to the various programs operated by the agency and performance measures 26 associated with each program of the agency. The performance 27 28 measures to be contained within the agency budget request shall be 29 developed by cooperative efforts of the Legislative Budget Office, the Department of Finance and Administration and the agency itself 30 31 and shall be approved jointly by the Legislative Budget Office and

- the Department of Finance and Administration prior to inclusion 32
- 33 within the agency budget request. Beginning with the 1996 fiscal
- year, the budget requests shall also include in an addendum format 34
- 35 a five-year strategic plan for the agency which shall include, but
- not be limited to, the following items of information: (a) a 36
- 37 comprehensive mission statement, (b) performance effectiveness
- objectives for each program of the agency for each of the five (5) 38
- years covered by the plan, (c) a description of significant 39
- 40 external factors which may affect the projected levels of
- performance, (d) a description of the agency's internal management 41
- 42 system utilized to evaluate its performance achievements in
- relationship to the targeted performance levels, (e) an evaluation 43
- by the agency of the agency's performance achievements in 44
- relationship to the targeted performance levels for the two (2) 45
- 46 preceding fiscal years for which accounting records have been
- 47 finalized.
- (2) All agencies enumerated in subsection (1) of this 48
- section shall include in their budget requests the following 49
- 50 information regarding contract workers for the most recently
- completed fiscal year: 51
- (a) The name of each worker; 52
- 53 The specific type of services provided;
- 54 Hourly rate of compensation, or the basis for
- 55 compensation if a rate other than the hourly rate is used;
- 56 (d) Total gross salary or wages paid; and
- (e) Whether the worker is a retired member of the 57
- Public Employees' Retirement System. 58
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59
- and after July 1, 2006. 60

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
