House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2670

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8	SECTION 1. Section 59-21-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	59-21-25. (1) Fees for the award of certificates of number
11	for original, transfer, renewal, livery, dealer and duplicate
12	shall be as follows:
13	(a) Less than 16 feet
14	(b) 16 feet but less than 26 feet
15	(c) 26 feet <u>but less than 40 feet</u> <u>\$45.00</u>
16	(d) <u>40 feet and over</u> \$45.00
17	<u>(e)</u> Dealer number <u>\$37.50</u>
18	<u>(f)</u> Duplicate <u>\$ 5.00</u>
19	(g) Boat inspection fee
20	(2) The fee provided for under subsection (1)(g) of this
21	section shall only be charged when the owner of a boat requests
22	the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks to perform an
23	inspection of a boat serial number for the purpose of replacing or
24	awarding a damaged or removed serial number.

(3) All fees for numbers and renewal of number shall be 25 payable to the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and 26 Parks to be deposited by the department in the State Treasury in a 27 28 special fund to be designated as the Fisheries and Wildlife Fund, which shall be disbursed upon the recommendation of the department 29 30 as may be appropriated by the Legislature. The State Treasurer shall release to the department such sums as are required to 31 defray all administrative costs of the boat registration fee 32 33 division of the department and to improve the law enforcement

B. 2670 PAGE 1 34 capability of the department on the inland and marine waters of 35 the State of Mississippi and as may be budgeted by the department for the purpose of paying the cost of the administration of this 36 37 chapter for education on water safety, improvement of water safety and motorboating facilities in the state, and advertising and 38 39 promoting the waterways of the state. Any and all revenue over and above the actual administrative cost of implementing this act 40 shall be used to fund salaries of additional conservation officers 41 42 in all eighty-two (82) counties.

43 SECTION 2. Section 59-21-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
44 amended as follows:

45 59-21-19. (1) The certificate of number shall be
46 pocket-size, approximately two and one-half inches (2-1/2") by
47 three and one-half inches (3-1/2"), and water resistant.

48 (2) Pending the issuance of the original certificate of 49 number, the owner of the vessel may be furnished a temporary 50 certificate of number valid for sixty (60) days from the date of 51 issue. This temporary certificate shall be carried on board when 52 the vessel is being operated.

53 (3) Each applicant for an original or transfer certificate 54 of number, who is entitled to issuance thereof, shall be issued a 55 certificate for a period of <u>three (3)</u> years from the last day of 56 the month of receipt of the original or transfer certificate. 57 This subsection shall not apply to the certificate of number of a 58 livery boat.

(4) The certificate of number of a livery boat shall be plainly marked "livery boat." The description of the motor and type of fuel will be omitted from the certificate of number in any case where the motor is not rented with the boat. Original and renewal certificates of number of a livery boat shall be valid for a period of <u>three (3)</u> years and shall expire at midnight on June 30 * * *.

(5) Numbers and certificates of number awarded boats
operated by manufacturers and dealers may be transferred from one
(1) boat to another. In lieu of the description, the word

"manufacturer" or "dealer," as appropriate, will be plainly marked 69 70 on each certificate. The manufacturer or dealer may have the number awarded printed upon or attached to a removable sign or 71 72 signs to be temporarily mounted upon or attached to the boat being 73 demonstrated or tested so long as the display meets the 74 requirements of Section 59-21-9. SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 75 and after July 1, 2006. 76

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
