

House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2843

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 71-5-503, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:

7 71-5-503. An individual's weekly benefit amount for a
8 benefit year shall be one-twenty-sixth (1/26) of his total wages
9 for insured work paid during that quarter of his base period in
10 which such total wages were highest, computed to the next lower
11 multiple of One Dollar (\$1.00), if not a multiple of One Dollar
12 (\$1.00).

13 On or before June 15 of each year, the total wages reported
14 on contribution reports for the preceding calendar year shall be
15 divided by the average monthly number of insured workers
16 (determined by dividing the total insured workers reported on
17 contribution reports pursuant to the regulations of the commission
18 for the preceding year by twelve (12)). The average annual wage
19 thus obtained shall be divided by fifty-two (52) and the average
20 weekly wage thus determined rounded to the nearest cent. Sixty
21 percent (60%) of this amount, rounded to the nearest dollar, shall
22 constitute the maximum "weekly benefit amount" paid to any
23 individual whose benefit year commences on or after July 1 of such
24 year and prior to July 1 of the next following year; provided,
25 however, that the maximum weekly benefit amount for the individual
26 shall not exceed: (a) Two Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$230.00) for
27 the benefit year that begins on * * * July 1, 2006; and (b) Two
28 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for any benefit year that begins
29 on or after July 1, 2007. The minimum weekly benefit amount for
30 the individual shall be Thirty Dollars (\$30.00). If an

31 individual's weekly benefit amount would compute to less than the
32 said minimum, then such individual would be entitled to no
33 benefits.

34 An individual's weekly benefit amount, as determined at the
35 beginning of his benefit year, shall constitute his weekly benefit
36 amount throughout such benefit year.

37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
38 and after July 1, 2006.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 71-5-503, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO INCREASE THE WEEKLY BENEFIT AMOUNT PAID TO INDIVIDUALS UNDER
3 THE UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
