## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2882

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. It is generally recognized that a significant 6 number of the population of the State of Mississippi has a form of 7 chronic kidney disease (CKD), including persons with seriously 8 reduced kidney function that may progress to end stage renal disease (ESRD) requiring kidney dialysis or the receipt of a 9 10 kidney transplant. ESRD is usually the result of years of CKD 11 caused by diabetes, high blood pressure or a family history of CKD as the primary contributing factors. Recognizing that the 12 13 treatment of CKD is a tremendous expense and that the early 14 diagnosis and effective treatment of CKD can prolong lives and delay the high cost of medical treatment, including dialysis 15 and/or transplantation, and that there are existing, cost-16 17 effective laboratory test calculations that can assist in the early diagnosis of CKD, there is created the Mississippi Chronic 18 19 Kidney Disease Task Force.

20 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The members of the Chronic Kidney Disease 21 Task Force shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of 22 Representatives, the Lieutenant Governor and the State Health 23 Officer as follows:

(a) The Speaker and the Lieutenant Governor each shall
appoint three (3) physicians from lists submitted by the
Mississippi State Medical Association and the Mississippi Medical
and Surgical Association, two (2) of whom shall be family
practitioners, two (2) of whom shall be nephrologists and two (2)
of whom shall be pathologists.

30 (b) The Speaker shall appoint one (1) member who
31 represents the state affiliate of the National Kidney Foundation
32 and one (1) member who represents the Department of Nephrology at
33 the University of Mississippi Medical Center.

34 (c) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint one (1)
35 member who represents owners/operators of clinical laboratories in
36 the state and one (1) member who represents a private renal care
37 provider.

38 (d) The State Health Officer shall appoint one (1)
39 member who is a dietitian licensed by the State of Mississippi.
40 (2) The State Health Officer or his designee shall serve as
41 chairperson of the task force.

42 (3) The State Department of Health shall provide meeting43 facilities for the task force.

44 **SECTION 3.** The Chronic Kidney Disease Task Force shall:

(a) Develop a plan to educate health care professionals about the advantages and methods of early screening, diagnosis and treatment of chronic kidney disease and its complications based on the K/DOQI Clinical Practice Guidelines for Chronic Kidney Disease or other medically recognized clinical practice guidelines and develop a plan to educate health care professionals about the advantages of End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) modality education;

52 (b) Make recommendations on the implementation of a 53 cost-effective plan for that early screening, diagnosis and 54 treatment of chronic kidney disease for the state's population; 55 and

(c) Issue a report to the membership of the House
Public Health and Human Services Committee and the Senate Public
Health and Welfare Committee before the 2007 Session of the
Mississippi Legislature.

SECTION 4. This act shall stand repealed on July 1, 2008.
 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
 and after July 1, 2006.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
