House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2915

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- Section 37-101-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 9 amended as follows: 37-101-3. (1) The Governor, by and with the advice and 10 consent of the Senate, shall appoint the members of the Board of 11 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, one (1) member 12 13 from each congressional district of the state as existing as of 14 March 31, 1944, one (1) member from each Supreme Court district and two (2) members from the state at large, with the terms of 15 16 each to begin on May 8, 1944. One-third (1/3) of the membership 17 of said board so appointed shall be appointed for a period of four (4) years, one-third (1/3) for a period of eight (8) years and 18 19 one-third (1/3) for a period of twelve (12) years. On the 20 expiration of any of said terms of office the Governor shall 21 appoint successors, by and with the advice and consent of the 22 Senate, for terms of twelve (12) years in each case. 23 The current president, or his/her designee, of the Student Body President's Council of Mississippi (SBPCM) shall have a 24 reserved seat at each meeting of the Board of Trustees of State 25 Institutions of Higher Learning. Not less than once a year, the 26 27 board shall seek the advice and counsel of the student body president's organization. 28 In case of a vacancy on said board by death or 29

resignation of a member or from any other cause than the

- 34 the Legislature the Governor shall appoint the successor member of
- 35 the board from the district from which his predecessor was
- 36 appointed to hold office until the end of the period or term for
- 37 which said original trustee was appointed, to the end that
- 38 one-third (1/3) of such trustees' terms shall expire each four (4)
- 39 years.
- 40 (3) The Executive Director of the State Board for Community
- 41 and Junior Colleges, or his designee, and one (1) member of the
- 42 State Board for Community and Junior Colleges to be designated by
- 43 the chairman of said board, shall attend all regular meetings of
- 44 the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning.
- 45 Said community/junior college representatives shall have no
- 46 jurisdiction or vote on any matter within the jurisdiction of the
- 47 board. The Executive Director of the State Board for Community
- 48 and Junior Colleges and any designee who is a state employee shall
- 49 receive no per diem for attending meetings of the board, but shall
- 50 be entitled to actual and necessary expense reimbursement and
- 51 mileage for attending meetings at locations other than Jackson,
- 52 Mississippi. The designee of the State Board for Community and
- 53 Junior Colleges shall receive per diem compensation as authorized
- 54 by Section 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, for attending said
- 55 meetings, and shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual
- 56 expense reimbursement and mileage, which shall be paid from funds
- 57 appropriated to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 58 Higher Learning.
- 59 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 60 and after July 1, 2006.
