## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2943

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

## 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Legislative findings.

- In the spirit of the report of the Governor's Commission on
- 6 Recovery, Rebuilding and Renewal, the Legislature finds that there
- 7 is a need for consolidation of water, wastewater, storm water and
- 8 solid waste services in order to reduce costs, promote resilience
- 9 in the event of disaster, improve the quality of the natural
- 10 environment, and improve the planning and delivery of quality
- 11 water, wastewater, storm water and solid waste services within the
- 12 areas of the Counties of George, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl
- 13 River and Stone. It is further declared that there is need for
- 14 the planning, acquisition, construction, maintenance, operation
- 15 and coordination of user-funded water, wastewater, storm water and
- 16 solid waste systems in order to ensure protection of the waters of
- 17 the state and to ensure the delivery of water, wastewater, storm
- 18 water and solid waste services to citizens of the Gulf Coast
- 19 Region. The creation of the Mississippi Gulf Region Utility Board
- 20 Act is determined to be necessary and essential to the
- 21 accomplishment of these purposes.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI GULF REGION UTILITY BOARD; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
