House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3006

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
7	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Ethics Commission for
8	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
9	\$ 525,610.00.
10	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
11	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
12	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
13	Permanent: Full Time 8
14	Part Time 0
15	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
16	Part Time 0
17	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
18	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
19	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
20	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
21	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
22	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
23	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
24	Mississippi Ethics Commission shall maintain complete accounting
25	and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
26	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
27	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
28	2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
29	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to

- the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 30
- 31 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 32
- 33 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 34
- 35 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 36 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 37 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 38 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 39
- 40 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 41
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 42
- credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 43
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 44
- 45 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 46
- 47 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 48 and after July 1, 2006.
