House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3027

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on July 1, 2006.

35 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 36 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 39 40 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 41 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 43 44 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 45 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 46 47 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 48 49 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 50 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 52 53 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 54 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 56

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57 58 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 59 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 60 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 61 The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 62 63 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

S. B. 3027 PAGE 2 64 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 65 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board Training Fund account, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Personnel Board Training Seminars for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007......\$ 542,493.00.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Personnel Board Training Fund shall have the authority, should additional funds become available, to escalate and expend those funds in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration, in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

The funds authorized under the provisions of this section shall be held separate and apart from all other funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Personnel Board.

85 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 86 Section 3, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 87 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 88 expenditure:

100 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Personnel Board shall have the authority to escalate and 101 102 expend funds received from state agencies for reimbursement of 103 costs associated with the hiring of court reporters used in the 104 Employee Appeals Process. Such funds shall be received and 105 expended under the rules and regulations of the Department of 106 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the 107 escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 108 109 State Personnel Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 110 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 111 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 112 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 113 2006. 114 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 115 116 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 117 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that 118 119 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 120 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 121 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 122 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 123 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 124 125 made without competitive bids.

126 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 127 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 128 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer, and the State Fiscal 129 130 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 131 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 132 and after July 1, 2006. 133
