House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3043

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as

31 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Permanent: 32 Full Time..... 54 33 Part Time..... Full Time..... 34 Time-Limited: 35 Part Time..... For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are 36 provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee 37 38 who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an 39 amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on 40 July 1, 2006. 41 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 42 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 43 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 44 45 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 46 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 47 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 49 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 50 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 51 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 54 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.

76 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the

77 Banking and Consumer Finance shall maintain complete accounting

78 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

79 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

80 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year

81 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

82 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to

83 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

84 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided

85 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

86 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

88 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

89 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

90 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

91 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

92 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

93 made without competitive bids.

94 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

96 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

97 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

99 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
